WHEREAS:

The JCRA published and served an initial notice on 24 October 2006 concerning a failure by Jersey Telecom Limited ('JT') to comply with Conditions 5.1(b) and 19.4 of its licence under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 (the 'Law') dated 1 July 2003;

Based on the events described in the initial notice, the JCRA has concluded that JT is in contravention of Conditions 5.1(b) and 19.4 of this licence. JT's contravention of these Conditions arise out of its failure to comply with the Direction on Mobile Number Portability issued by the JCRA to JT and other operators on 5 June 2006; and

Article 19 of the Law states that where, in the JCRA's opinion, a licensee is in contravention of a licensee condition, the JCRA shall give a direction to the licensee to take steps, or specified steps, to ensure compliance with that condition.

UNDER ARTICLE 19 OF THE LAW, THE JCRA HEREBY DIRECTS THAT:

In order to ensure compliance with Conditions 5.1(b) and 19.4 of its licence, JT shall comply with the JCRA's Direction on Mobile Number Portability dated 5 June 2006, as it may be amended from time to time by the JCRA.
