NOTICE OF EXTENSION TO INTERIM LICENCE

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA'), having received a request from Jersey Telecom Limited to extend their interim Licence to run a telecommunication system in Jersey and in exercise of its powers under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, intends to grant Jersey Telecom Limited an extension of 61 days for the interim and conditional Class III licence for the running of a telecommunications system.

The JCRA is of the opinion that by acceding to the request of Jersey Telecom Limited for the grant of this extension will help to allow further consideration to be given to the grant of a more permanent licence. This extension will help to ensure that telecommunications services are properly provided, both within Jersey and between Jersey and the rest of the world, as satisfy all current and prospective demands and will help promote competition among persons engaged in commercial activities connected with telecommunications in Jersey.

This extension will provide that the current interim Licence will terminate on 30 June 2003.
