INITIAL NOTICE OF CLASS III LICENCE

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA') in exercise of its powers under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, intends to grant Jersey Telecom Limited a Class III licence for the running of a telecommunications system in Jersey.

The JCRA is of the opinion that the grant of this Licence will ensure that telecommunications services are properly provided, both within Jersey and between Jersey and the rest of the world, as to satisfy all current and prospective demands and will help promote competition among persons engaged in commercial activities connected with telecommunications in Jersey.

The Licence will commence on 1 July 2003 and will be for a period of fifteen (15) years.

A copy of the licence and this notice is available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday.

Written representations or objections to the exercise of this specified regulatory function may be made by letter marked for the attention of the Executive Director, JCRA and delivered to 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey, JE2 3RF on or before 23 May 2003.
