INITIAL NOTICE

The Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 is to be brought fully into force on 1 January 2003.

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA'), having received an application from Newtel Limited to run a telecommunication system in Jersey and in exercise of its powers under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, intends to grant Newtel Limited a Class II licence for ten years for the running of a telecommunications system.

The JCRA is of the opinion that the grant of a licence will help to ensure that telecommunications services are provided, both within Jersey and between Jersey and the rest of the world, as satisfy all current and prospective demands and will help promote competition among persons engaged in commercial activities connected with telecommunications in Jersey.

A copy of the licence and this notice is available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday.

It is intended that the licence will be granted on 15 January 2003.

Written representations or objections to the exercise of this specified regulatory function may be made by letter marked for the attention of the Executive Director, JCRA and delivered to 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey, JE2 3RF on or before 10 January 2003.
