

TELECOMMUNICATIONS (JERSEY) LAW 2002

NEWTEL LIMITED

INITIAL NOTICE

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA'), having carried out a review of the Class II Licence granted to Newtel Limited on 15 January 2003 and in exercise of its powers under Article 18 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, intends to modify the conditions contained in the licence.

The amendments will license Newtel's Broadband Cable Television Network covered by a licence granted under the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law, 1972 due to expire on 31 December 2003, extend the term of the licence from ten to fifteen years and other minor amendments to create a more positive framework for investment in telecommunications services in the Bailiwick of Jersey.

The JCRA is of the opinion that the amendments are desirable to ensure the continued provision of telecommunications services to the public of Jersey

Copies of the present licence, the amended licence and this notice are available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday.

It is intended that the licence will be granted on 1 December 2003.

Written representations or objections to the exercise of these specified regulatory functions may be made by letter marked for the attention of the Executive Director, JCRA and delivered to 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey, JE2 3RF on or before 25 November 2003.
