to run telecommunication systems in Jersey and in exercise of its powers under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, intends to grant Class I licences to Links Communications, Nitel Limited and Interactive Online Limited.

The JCRA is of the opinion that the grant of these licences will help to ensure that telecommunications services are provided, both within Jersey and between Jersey and the rest of the world, as satisfy all current and prospective demands and will help promote competition among persons engaged in commercial activities connected with telecommunications in Jersey.

It is intended that the licences will be granted on 31 December 2002 and will come into full effect when the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 is brought fully into force on 1 January 2003.
