TELECOMMUNICATIONS (JERSEY) LAW 2002

CABLE AND WIRELESS GUERNSEY LIMITED

INITIAL NOTICE

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA') having received a request from Cable and Wireless Guernsey Limited with regard to the Class I Licence granted to them on the 15 August 2003, intends to amend that licence.

The proposed amendment removes Condition 15 which currently prohibits the Licensee from running its Public Telecommunications System other than for the transit of telecommunications between the Bailiwick of Guernsey and France, and from connecting to another Licensed Operator in the Bailiwick of Jersey.

This amendment will enable Cable and Wireless Guernsey Limited to interwork with Cable and Wireless Jersey Limited, to whom the JCRA has awarded a Class II Licence.

The JCRA is therefore of the opinion that the amendment of this Licence will help to ensure that telecommunications services are provided, both within Jersey and between Jersey and the rest of the world, as satisfy all current and prospective demands and will help promote competition among persons engaged in commercial activities connected with telecommunications in Jersey.

Copies of the Licence and this notice are available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday.

It is intended that the Licence amendment will take effect as from 10 December 2003.
