INITIAL NOTICE

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA') granted a Class I Licence to Crown Castle UK Limited to run a telecommunications system in Jersey on 22 June 2004.

On 28 June 2004, Crown Castle UK Holdings Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of Crown Castle International Corp, a US registered Company, agreed the sale of their entire share holding to NGG Telecoms Investment Limited (NGG), a subsidiary of National Grid Transco plc. NGG will purchase the entire share capital of Crown Castle UK Limited, the Licence holder in Jersey

The JCRA intend to approve this change of control of the Company in accordance with Condition 2.6 of the Class I Licence issued to Crown Castle UK Ltd and amend their Licence to reflect this change in line with Articles 10, 11 and 18 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002. NGG already operate a number of transmitter sites and this purchase will consolidate their portfolio. For the purposes of regulation, the change of ownership will not impact on the suitability of the licensee to operate in Jersey.

Copies of the amended Licence and this notice are available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at 6^{th} Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday.

It is intended that the Licence will be amended on 20 August 2004.
