**INITIAL NOTICE**

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA'), having received an application from SSD Communications (Jersey) Limited to run a telecommunications system in Jersey and in exercise of its powers under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, intends to grant a Class I Licence to SSD Communications (Jersey) Limited.

The JCRA is of the opinion that the grant of this Licence will help to ensure that telecommunications services are provided, both within Jersey and between Jersey and the rest of the world, as satisfy all current and prospective demands and will help promote competition among persons engaged in commercial activities connected with telecommunications in Jersey.

Copies of the Licence and this notice are available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday.

It is intended that the Licence will be granted on 21 June 2005.
