## **INITIAL NOTICE**

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA'), having received an application from Jersey Telecom Limited to run a telecommunication system in Jersey and in exercise of its powers under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, intends to grant Jersey Telecom Limited an interim and conditional Class III licence for the running of a telecommunications system.

The JCRA is of the opinion that the grant of a licence will help to ensure that telecommunications services are provided, both within Jersey and between Jersey and the rest of the world, as satisfy all current and prospective demands and will help promote competition among persons engaged in commercial activities connected with telecommunications in Jersey.

A copy of the licence and this notice is available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at  $6^{\text{th}}$  Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday.

It is intended that the licence will be granted on 1 November 2002 on a deferred basis and will come into full effect when the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 is brought fully into force. This is currently anticipated to be on 1 December 2002 (although the date may be subject to change).

Written representations or objections to the exercise of this specified regulatory function may be made by letter marked for the attention of the Executive Director, JCRA and delivered to 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey, JE2 3RF on or before 31 October 2002.
