TELECOMMUNICATIONS (JERSEY) LAW 2002

GENERAL CLASS LICENCES

INITIAL NOTICE

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA'), being the competent authority for the licensing of telecommunications under the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, and in exercise of its powers under Article 18 (1) of the Law intends, of its own motion, to modify the Class Licences issued under the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 1972.

The reason for the modification is that the JCRA has taken over the responsibility for telecommunications licensing in Jersey as from 1 January 2002.

The Licences to be modified are the E-commerce Telecommunication System, Payphone, Self Provided Telecommunications Systems, Private Branch Exchange, Electronic Mail and Private Mobile Radio Class Licences.

The modification to the E-commerce Telecommunication System, Payphone, Self Provided Telecommunications Systems, Private Branch Exchange and Electronic Mail Class Licences deletes the word 'Board' from paragraph 3 and inserts the words 'Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority'. The modification to the Private Mobile Radio Class Licence deletes the words 'States of Jersey Telecommunications Board' from paragraph 7 and inserts the words 'Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority'.

Copies of the present Licences, amended Licences and a copy of this notice are available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at 6th Floor, Union House, St Helier, Jersey between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday.

It is intended that the modified Licences will come into effect on 7 January 2004.
