INITIAL NOTICE

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA'), having received an application from the States of Jersey Harbours and Airport Committee for Jersey Airport to run a telecommunication system in Jersey and in exercise of its powers under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002, intends to grant Jersey Airport a conditional Class II licence for ten years for the running of a telecommunications system.

The JCRA is of the opinion that the grant of this Licence is necessary to ensure the continued provision of telecommunications services to the public of Jersey.

Copies of the Licence and this notice are available for inspection at the offices of the JCRA at 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey, between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday. This Initial Notice supersedes that issued on the 22 July 2004.

It is intended that the Licence will be granted on 1 September 2004.

Written representations or objections to the exercise of these specified regulatory functions may be made by letter marked for the attention of the Executive Director, JCRA and delivered to 6th Floor, Union House, Union Street, St Helier, Jersey, JE2 3RF on or before 31 August 2004.
