

**INITIAL NOTICE OF A PROPOSED CLASS I POSTAL  
OPERATOR'S LICENCE TO REGENCY HOLDINGS LIMITED**

**Under Article 24 of Postal Services (Jersey) Law 2004 ("the Law")**

---

1. The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority ('JCRA') in exercise of its powers under Article 15 of the Postal Services (Jersey) Law 2004 ('the Law'), proposes to grant Regency Holdings Limited a Class I Postal Operator's Licence to receive, process and deliver Licensed Letters (as defined in the draft Licence) to addresses in the Island of Jersey; and to receive, process and deliver to addresses in the Island of Jersey Inbound Letters (as defined in the draft Licence) sent by Mail-Order Catalogue companies.
2. Subject to any comments it may receive concerning this proposal, the JCRA is of the opinion that the grant of this Licence is consistent with its duties as set forth in Article 8 of the Law. In summary, the JCRA understands that there is a demand in Jersey for the services that would be subject to the licence, and that the grant of the licence would otherwise be consistent with the considerations, to the extent applicable, set out in Articles 8(2) and 8(3) of the Law.
3. The draft Licence will take effect on 24 June 2008, unless the JCRA receives representations or objections about the proposal prior to that date, in which case the effective date will be specified in any Final Notice issued by the JCRA under Article 24(5) of the Law.
