



## INITIAL NOTICE CICRA 16/32

### TELECOMMUNICATIONS (JERSEY) LAW 2002

#### Marathon Telecom Limited

In 2010, The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority (the ‘**Authority**’) in exercise of its powers under Article 14 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 granted Marathon Telecom Limited (‘**Marathon**’) a Class I Licence to run a telecommunications system in Jersey.

The Authority has reviewed the licence granted to Marathon.

The Authority has determined that in order to effectively regulate all operators licenced in Jersey to provide mobile telecommunications all operators should at least hold a Class II Licence.

In exercise of its powers under Articles 14 and 18 of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 The Authority therefore intends to grant a Class II Licence to Marathon for the remainder of its licence period. It is intended that the Class II Licence will be granted on 27 September 2016.
