

CASE OPENING STATEMENT

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority (the **Authority**) is in possession of information which suggests that two or more businesses in Jersey's transportation, logistics and storage sector have been party to an agreement which may have detrimentally effected competition in this sector.

Arrangements between one or more undertakings (businesses) that have the object or effect of hindering competition in any market Jersey are prohibited under Article 8(1) of the Competition (Jersey) Law 2005 (the **Competition Law**)¹. Therefore, pursuant to Article 26(1) of the Competition Law the Authority has decided to conduct an investigation into the suspected contravention. The investigation will be progressed in line with the Authority's published investigation procedures which can be found here: <u>Guideline 10 - Investigation Procedures</u>. As this is a live investigation, no further details will be made available at this time.
