Issue of Class I Telecommunications Licence in Jersey

Following an application from Gamma Telecom Holdings Limited (GTHL) the JCRA proposes to exercise its powers under article 14 of the *Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002* and grant a Class I Telecommunications Licence to GTHL.

GTHL is a wholly owned subsidiary of Gamma Communications plc, a UK based telecoms operator, listed on the LSE AIM (Alternative Investment Market), which focuses on providing services to business customers.
