## Information Note

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority (the **Authority**) published an Initial Notice dated 30 March 2021 (the <u>Initial Notice</u>) under Article 11(1) of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 (**Telecoms Law**), relating to the exercise of a specified regulatory function, being the proposed modification under Article 18 of the Telecoms Law of each of the following licences granted under Article 14(1) of that Law:

- to JT (Jersey) Limited (JT), dated 30 June 2017 (the JT Licence); and
- to Sure (Jersey) Limited (Sure), dated 1 September 2015 (the Sure Licence).

The modification in each case was the addition of certain licence conditions. The Initial Notice set out:

- the text of proposed additional licence conditions (Licence Conditions); and
- the process and timetable for making representations to the Authority in relation to the Licence Conditions.

The period during which such representations could be made ended at 5pm on 30 April 2021. The Initial Notice provided that:

- if no responses were received before such time, the Final Notice effecting such modification would be made on or about 7 May 2021. At such time as the modification took effect, it would become binding on all parties.
- if representations were received before such time, the Authority would consider them and would decide:
  - o not to exercise the specified regulatory function (ie not to implement the modifications);
  - o to issue a new Initial Notice; or
  - o to issue a Final Notice confirming the modification of the JT Licence and the Sure Licence.

Representations were received from one of the other licensed operators, in accordance with the requirements of the Initial Notice. Accordingly, the Authority is considering such representations and will make a decision in due course, in which event further information or notices will be published on the Authority's website under Case Number T-038.
