## 1. Executive Summary

- 1.1 The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority (the **Authority**), determined in its Decision and Directions to JT (Jersey) Limited (**JT**) of 17 September 2021, that JT had contravened Conditions 9 and 14.1 of its Licence under the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002 (**Telecoms Law**). It issued Further Directions to JT on 17 March 2022.
- 1.2 Article 19A of the Telecoms Law empowers the Authority to impose a financial penalty in addition to a Direction under Article 19(1). On 16 February 2022, the Authority published an Information Notice stating that it had issued a notification of its intention to impose a financial penalty on JT and a draft of such order. JT was entitled to make representation in respect of such draft order during the consultation period set out in Article 19A.
- 1.3 JT has notified the Authority that it accepts the imposition of a financial penalty under Article 19A. Accordingly, this is an order imposing a financial penalty pursuant to Article 19A of the Telecoms Law on JT.

## 2. Order

### **ORDER**

**The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority hereby orders a financial penalty on JT (Jersey) Limited for the contravention of Licence Conditions 9 and 14 of the Class III Licence issued to JT, in accordance with Article 19A of the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 2002.**

**The level of that penalty is set at £90,000 (ninety thousand pounds) and is to be paid in full to the Authority within 28 days of the date of this Order.**
