JERSEY 5G PUBLIC COMMENT

Please find enclosed with this covering letter comprehensive scientific studies on the harms of radio frequencies especially pertaining to mobile phone masts and related technology.

These documents are being submitted as part of the request for public comment on the rollout of 5G on Jersey.

It is to be made clear that the issue with these frequencies is as much related to 4G as it is to 5G.

The States of Jersey were warned in 2007 that the 3G roll out of the mobile phone system was a potential and likely hazard to health and those minutes are documented on the States of Jersey website. This information was ignored.

The following points need to be noted and discussed with all relevant risk assessments submitted.

The responsibility of the JCRA, States of Jersey Environmental and Health Departments is:

- 1. To apply the Precautionary Principle to all legislation regarding future connectivity on the island. (The data that the States of Jersey, the JCRA and telecom corporations are using is outdated and incomplete.)
- 2. To conduct an independent investigation into the ICNIRP and to establish if there are other more up to date and cautious regulatory bodies that take into account not just thermal effects on the body but also electromagnetic effects on the human biosphere.

- 3. To set up an independent panel of inquiry into the current 4G Mast emission readings and their cumulative effect over time.
- 4. To set up an independent panel to monitor and evaluate epidemiological evidence of EMF radiation poisoning on the island working with mental health services, cancer charities and neurologists.
- 5. To implement a 300 metre safe distance of all mobile phone masts from schools, residential areas, offices and places where vulnerable people reside.

The JCRA and its staff members will be held personally liable for any and all health related issues related to a future roll out of 5G on the island which is being collated in the form of a qualitative study by a group of concerned citizens that number over 900.
