



CASE CLOSING STATEMENT

The Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority (the JCRA) has closed its investigation into a suspected anti-competitive arrangement in Jersey's transportation, logistics and storage sector, without finding a breach of the Competition (Jersey) Law 2005.

Being an island, Jersey is dependent on the transportation of goods onto and off the Island, with imports being almost entirely sea based. The carriage of goods by sea and freight logistics connections supports the Island's supply chains, retail sector, construction industry, and essential lifeline services and is therefore essential to consumers, businesses and the wider economy.

The JCRA is grateful to all individuals and businesses that engaged with it through the investigation process and the information provided to it. Whilst the investigation is closed, the JCRA will continue to engage further with businesses (large and small) whilst it considers future work in this sector.
